

CONDITIONS OF APPLICATION TO MARGRETHE-SKOLEN - 2012/2013

This education is recognized by the Danish Ministry of Education. Danish students can therefore apply for a government grant.

1. Course requirements:

Applicants must be over 18 and personally attend an interview.

Artistic and practical creations must be presented.

The applicant's work will be assessed by the leadership of Margrethe-Skolen.

2. Conditions of payment:

There is an enrollment deposit of 4,000 DKK which is refunded on payment of the 4th term.

In cases of cancellation or interruption of tuition the deposit is forfeited.

School fees total 144,000 DKK and are to be paid as follows:

1st payment	1st June	36,000 DKK
2nd payment	1st November	36,000 DKK
3rd payment	1st May	36,000 DKK
4th payment	1st November	36,000 DKK

During the school year there will be current expenses for materials and study tour.

After confirmation of enrollment the student is committed to payment of the whole school year with the following exceptions:

If a student leaves the school during the academic year, the student forfeits as following:

- 1) Cancellation before the start of the academic year (not however if the student is replaced by another): Enrollment deposit of 4,000 DKK
- 2) Suspension of studies during the first 3 months: Fees for the first term.
- 3) Suspension of studies after the first term: Remaining school fees for the year.

Written notification of discontinued studies must be sent to the school leadership.

Should studies be interrupted by unforeseen, serious events which make continuation unreasonable or impossible (force majeure) only received tuition must be paid for.

Should the school be closed because of fire or other force majeure, the school is free of responsibility, compensation or reparations, as such events lie outside its control.

3. Tuition:

Teaching starts in the middle of August, and ends late June.

In addition, week 31 (Copenhagen Fashion Week) is reserved for graduation show for 4th semester and exhibition for 2nd semester.

Tuition takes place from Monday to Friday from 9.00 to 14.30, including a 30 minute lunch-break.

Tuition is given in English and Danish.

School holidays generally follow the Danish school year.

4 .General:

-The director of the school reserves the right to change the teaching plan within the agreed framework of tuition.

-Under tuition it is compulsory for students to arrive on time and to be present during lessons.

-An absence of over 15% will result in forfeiture of the graduation diploma.

-The school's rules of general conduct must be followed.

-An enrolled student is obliged to deliver completed assignments on time.

-The school expects that students have access to a sewing-machine outside the school.

-The school expects each student to have their own pc/laptop.

-The school has a copyright on all work created under the auspices of the institution.

5. Study-tour.

The school arranges a first year study-tour of 4-8 days with a guide to Paris. The price of this trip is not included in school fees.

There must be a minimum of 15 participants.
